


Response locations (by postcode)

Comments on community benefit

- "Speed calming measures on Tarvit Terrace, Springfield.
- Fibre network services (Eg Virgin)"
- This work should all be completed and paid for by Fife Council not a community benefit payment. The park is not completed and we were promised this. The creation of a youth club in the village hall, making it more of a community hub with activities for all ages would be a better suggestion which would benefit everyone from birth onwards. There should be a playgroup, fitness classes, youth club, scouts, BBs, brownies or guides should be going on there as well as coffee mornings, boot sales, charity benefits.
- Total refurb of village hall and community trust community council take over running village hall
- Upgrade in the village hall. Hanging baskets for community.
- Village hall badly needs finds to upgrade for the community use, no one wants to use it in the state it's in
- Park is definitely needing finished.
- Some sort of keep fit classes for the elderly and craft classes .

- Better signage of local walks and core paths."


- "No more houses please keep as a village thats whats attractive.

- Fixing all the pot holes,
- Getting more people involve in community projects, the Trust could a lot more if there were more volunteers. Banking at Hammerhead Toll looking towards Cupar lowered to improve visibility of vehicles coming from that direction in the interests of safety. Path to Stratheden badly needs remedial work done, a leaf blower to clear debris in the Autumn would help stop the leave mulch making the path difficult to traverse in places especially for those on wheeled vehicles could cause a cyclist to fall. Parking restrictions either side of these "traffic islands" similar to the ones at pedestrian crossings especially on Station Rd at Arthur Pl.

- More play equipment in the park. An annual community trash pick to tidy up our village.


- "Definitely a new shelter for the kids in the school. Will be beneficial in rain and strong sunshine.
- •Would also be nice to see the park finished, there's not much equipment for the kids to play on. We also have a little boy in the village who attends Springfield Primary one day a week (p3) and Kilmaron School the rest of the week who is in a wheelchair. He loves the basket swing but its really the only thing he can go on and as there's only one and its so popular with all the kids it's not fair for him to be on it all of the time. It'd be nice if there was maybe a couple of those springy things he could sit on and wobble back and forward on or a seesaw or even a ramp accessible slide as he can get around on his knees and loves the outdoors.
- Another suggestion for a very small portion of the funds. Could we please have a sign at the top of Crawford Park just near the top corner to encourage cars to slow down before turning the corner? The speed cars come round that corner now it's a through road into Laurel Brae is frightening. The kids play in the street and cars have no visibility until they turn the corner and they are travelling much faster than before when it was a cul-de-sac as they have further to drive now before having to slow down for the traffic calming which is well into the new development. There are more kids around now due to the new houses and they often play together as they are all friends from school. This village has already lost 2 beautiful girls as a result of being knocked down, we don't want the same thing to happen again.
- •Last suggestion it would be nice if both entrances to the village could be made a bit more attractive. When the daffodils are out at the station end its lovely but as the grass slope is rarely cut by fife council its normally an overgrown mess the rest of the year. Is there anything that could be done to keep it a bit tidier? Even an extra cut or 2 annually might help although i know its an awkward slope to maintain. Colour is always nice. I always think the colourful crocus in springtime on the green in Pitlessie looks very pretty. Something like that would be nice in the village. Possibly on the flat grassy bit up from the shop near the school carpark would be lovely to look at when out and about. ".




- Landline problems shouldn't be fixed with this money that's up to the providers

3. Home Broadband


Count of Download Speed for home broadband now

Count of Your broadband provider is:





Comments on broadband


- breaks down occasionally




Count of 4G (or 3G) data connectivity
